Good news! The American Red Cross will hold a blood donation drive right here in our neighborhood, at the North Rosedale Park Community House, 18445 Scarsdale, on Wednesday, June 3rd from 1-7 pm.

All social distancing requirements will be strictly observed – masks are required and a minimum of 6 feet of distance between people will be maintained at all times, except during the process of having your history taken and during the actual blood draw procedure when the nurse will approach to draw your blood. If you do not have a mask, one will be provided to you.

Bonus opportunity for those who have had COVID-19 and have recovered: you can donate your plasma, to be used to help patients with especially severe cases of the virus.
