The RPIA Public Works Committee was unable to find vendors willing to plow the sidewalks with the same business model as Greener Still. So it's up to us to push the snow off the public sidewalks. We are encouraging people with snow blowers to work together to clear as much snow as possible from the public sidewalks.
